The ACT Community Sector invites you to join us at our 11th annual NAIDOC celebrations for a day filled with performances and workshops by First Nations artists, as well as stalls, activities, food and drinks.

When: Wednesday 1 October 2025, 10:00am-2:00pm (bump in 9-10, bump out 2-3)

Where: Woden Town Square, including new CIT front courtyard

The ACT Community Sector is seeking expressions of interest from local artisans and vendors to hold a stall in the marketplace at the 2025 NAIDOC event on 1 October 2025.

Attracting hundreds of visitors, this annual NAIDOC event celebrates the history, culture, and achievements of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples in the ACT. In 2025, the theme for NAIDOC week is The Next Generation: Strength, Vision & Legacy, highlighting the enduring strength of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people.

Please note, while NAIDOC week is observed in Australia in July, this annual day of celebration is held in October due to the unpredictability of weather in the ACT.

There is no cost for stallholders at this event. However, we require all stallholders to provide their own tables, table coverings, and chairs. Vehicle access to the event will be limited, so we advise stallholders to bring their own trolleys for bump in and bump out. There is no access to power at this site.

EOI applications close at 12pm (noon), Wednesday 6 August 2025.

In order to provide a vibrant NAIDOC week event that reflects the diversity of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander cultures in the ACT, we will endeavour to program a variety of stall holders and vendors (in addition to artists and performers). Whilst we cannot guarantee that every EOI will be successful, your application is important to us and will be carefully considered. Applicants will be advised of the outcome of their application on Wednesday 27 August 2025.
